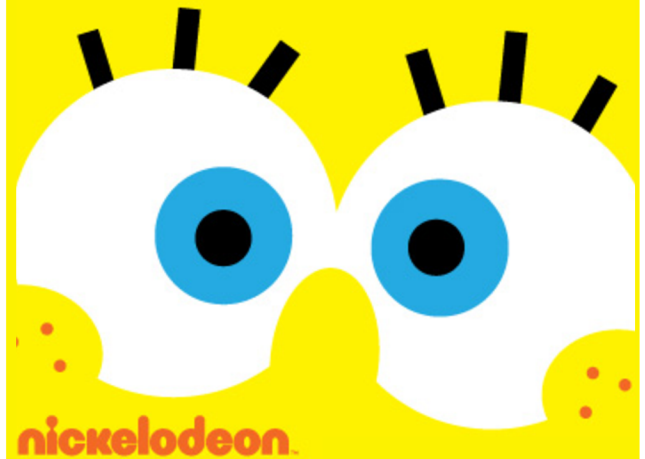

- Team 2: Kylie McAllaster and Ava Edelson

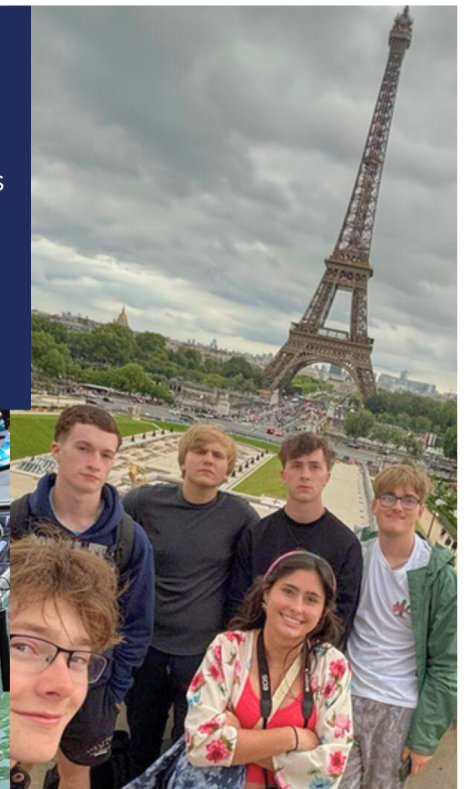
