2021 Summer Camp COVID-19 Guidelines

We are grateful you have decided to participate in the LaGrange Academy 2021 Summer Camp program. Our teachers have designed engaging camps for a wide variety of interests. We are confident your child will have a wonderful experience where they will explore, learn, and grow through their experiences with us.

In an effort to maintain the safety of our campers and teachers, LaGrange Academy has adopted the following guidelines and recommendations for all 2021 Summer Camps:

Small-Group Cohorts- With multiple camps taking place each week, all campers will remain with their single camp cohort. Different camps will not be interacting with one another at any point in the day.

Daily Temperature Screening- All campers and teachers will undergo a temperature screening each morning. Any person experiencing a temperature of 100.4°F or higher will not be allowed to attend camp.

Masks Optional- With the low rate of COVID cases in Troup County and the low level of transmission between children, masks and face coverings will be optional. However, we do recognize that masks and face coverings are still recommended by the CDC and the GA DPH for children at summer camps.

Sanitation Measures- All campers will be made to use hand sanitizer upon entering or exiting their classrooms/areas. All surfaces and classrooms will be sanitized at the conclusion of each day. Additionally, our facilities are equipped with enhanced filtration and ventilation systems.
